
Mark Up - OLD GISWeb

- 1. To use the Mark Up go to the Markup tab and type in your name or a title in the "Your Name" area, then click on "New".
- 2. You can then use any of the tools to draw on the map
- 3. From there you can print or save the map, note that it is available to the public for all to see unless you delete it once you are done.



Draw/Mark Up - NEW GISWeb

- 1. To draw on a map temporarily click on the Draw tab and then go to Quick Sketch.
 - a. Pick the type of feature you want to draw or use the measure tools
 - b. Then draw on the map by left clicking, moving to the next point and left clicking. To stop drawing double left click.
 - c. You can then print or save this as a PDF, but it will not stay on the map if you close out of the browser.



- 2. To do a permanent drawing that will stay on the gis web do the following:
 - a. Click on Create Markup
 - b. Enter information in the "Your Name" field
 - c. Click "New" and you will see the map show up in the Markup History. This will stay here until you delete it, but everyone can also see it, it is public
